



Elaine Dahse Feldcamp Memorial Scholarship

In 1955 Elaine Dahse graduated from Weimar High School. She was born here in Weimar in 1937 to Norwin & Erma (Brandes) Dahse. Historically, Elaine Dahse's family, (Dahse and Brandes), have been affiliated with Trinity Church over a significant number of years and are related to some of the current members of Trinity Church.

Elaine graduated as valedictorian of our class and went on to the University of Texas, graduating in 1960 with a BA degree with High Honors in History and Education and a minor in Sociology. She taught English at Texas City High School for 4 1/2 years. She married Larry Feldcamp in 1964 before moving to Austin in 1965. Larry obtained his law degree from Texas

Elaine passed away on March 26, 2019, while still residing in Bellingham, Washington. In July, Larry and his sons, were asking for assistance in setting up a scholarship program in memory of Elaine. Weimar, Columbus and Rice Consolidated High Schools will each receive each year (1) \$5,000 four-year scholarship (\$1,250 yearly) and (1) two-year \$3,000 college or technical school scholarship (\$1,500) yearly. The fund is set to last for ten (10) years and will be administered by Trinity Church with committee members from Weimar, Columbus and Rice Consolidated area. Larry wanted the scholarships for all of the county's high schools. There will be \$8,000 awarded to each of the three area high schools each year.

The purpose of the scholarships is to provide funds to less fortunate students or with financial need, to assist them with their continued education. Trinity Church is so blessed to be a part of this program with being able to help local students continue their education.
