Essay must be at least one full page and not more than two pages, double spaced.** Please submit **three (3) copies** of the essay for the judges to read. Please be sure the photocopies are legible as illegible essays will be disqualified. Essays that are hand written will be disqualified as well.
2. Sections 1 and 2 are to be **completed on the sheet labeled Part III with no additional sheets attached and signed by the School Counselor and the Youth Minister or Parish Priest. Please submit (3) three copies of this page.**
3. The applicant **must not mention his/her name or make any other identifying reference within the essay, on the essay, or Part III.** Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
4. **ALL APPLICATIONS AND ESSAYS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY APRIL 30, 2020.**

Section 1 25%

School Activities: UIL programs, leadership positions, sports, Community, and institution that you plan to attend.

Section 2 25%

Church Activities: involvement in Church and community.

While applicants must address all three sections, the greatest emphasis should be placed on Sections 3.

Section 3 50%

The Essay – Respond fully to the following question and do not include any activities from Sections 1 and 2
