24 Hour Rule Exclusion from School for Health Reasons

To protect all children from communicable illnesses (transfer from person to person, etc.), students infected with certain diseases are not allowed to come to school while they are contagious. **Students should be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to school.** Contact the Weimar ISD school nurse if you are unsure whether or not your child should return to school.

The guidelines below have been developed for the exclusion of students who have communicable or contagious diseases. These regulations are in compliance with the requirements of the local health authority, Weimar ISD Administrative Guidelines.

- 1. A student with any of the following symptoms will be excluded from school until such time as the student is free of symptoms, has been satisfactorily treated, or submits a signed physician's statement that he/she is not contagious.
 - Temperature of 100.0 degrees or more. Students must be fever free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry.
 - Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea. Students must be symptom free for 24 hours without medication before re-entry.
 - Pain and/or swelling at the angle of jaw.
 - Undetermined rash over any part of the body.
 - Undiagnosed scaly patches on the body or scalp.
 - Red, draining eyes.
 - Intense itching with signs and symptoms of secondary infection.
 - Open, draining lesions.
 - Jaundice (Yellowish appearance of skin)
- 2. The Principal or his/her designee, in collaboration with the school nurse, will notify parents that the student must be excluded for medical reasons.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to transport the student from school to his/her home in a timely manner.
- 4. For readmission, some diseases may require a statement from the student's physician affirming that the student is not contagious.
