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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD REGARDING WAGE PAYMENT DURING EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

WHEREAS the Board acknowledges that during an emergency closing, most District employees are instructed not to report for work. The Board concludes that a need exists to address wage payments for employees who are idled.

WHEREAS employees who are instructed not to report to work may suffer a loss of pay unless the workdays are made up at a later date. The Board concludes that continuing wage payments to all employees, contractual and non-contractual, salaried and non-salaried, who suffer a loss in pay due to an emergency closing, serves the public purposes of maintaining morale, reducing turnover, and ensuring continuity of District staffing when schools reopen.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Weimar Independent School District authorizes continued wage payments to all employees, contractual and non-contractual, salaried and non-salaried, who are instructed not to report to work during an emergency closing, unless the workdays are scheduled to be made up at a later date.



Beginning at a cotton spindle set in ashpalt at the intersection of the South right-of-way of West Huvar Street (30' right-of-way) and the East right of way of "Park Drive" (60' right-of-way) for the Northwest corner of said Block 94, the Northwest corner of said (original) 8 acre Otto Rahlwest tract, the Northwest corner of the herein described tract and the PLACE OF BEGINNING, said point having a coordinate value of N= 13,812,441.84 feet and E= 2,671,592.17 feet according to the Texas State Plane Coordinate System - South Central Zone - NAD 83(2011);
